

Authorised SRE Provider

Finley Community Church Incorporated is an authorised SRE provider. As required by the Department of Education and Communities we have in place a system of initial and ongoing training encompassing, but not limited to, building and delivering class lessons, knowledge of lesson content and authorised curriculum, classroom behaviour and management, and child protection. As part of initial training, we have adopted the modules from the Baptist Churches NSW and ACT which are in line with the outcomes of the training standard agreed between the major denominations through ICCOREIS in 2012.

Module 1 - Teaching SRE in Government Schools (*SRE DVD Training Book 1) Covers the 2013 government guidelines, essential do's and don'ts, a teacher's responsibilities and support, and lots about SRE and contemporary schools.

Module 2 - Learning and Teaching (*SRE DVD Training Book 2) Explores the idea of effective communication in the SRE classroom, SRE appropriate language, how children learn and what makes a good teacher.

Module 3 - Preparing and Delivering Lessons (*SRE DVD Training Book 3) Looking at the curriculum, the characteristics of children at different stages, and appropriate sharing of your own experience.

Module 4 - Communicating in the Classroom (*SRE DVD Training Book 4) Taking a fresh look at classroom management in today's schools, understanding what kids need to learn, and the principles and skills for teachers to use to set a great learning environment.
